

## 8 Steps to a Main Motion

It is easy for any Member of the Chapter to engage in Chapter Meetings by making a motion. Motions can be used to bring new business before the Chapter or propose action be taken on a pending matter. Only one main motion can be considered at a given time by the assembly. As the Parliamentarian, it is your job to ensure that the proper procedure is followed by any Member making a motion as follows:

- Member seeks recognition by the Chair
- Member is recognized by the Chair
- **3** Member states the motion
- Another Member seconds the motion
- The Chair restates the motion as made and seconded
- 6 Members discuss or debate the motion
- The chair takes a vote
- The chair announces the results of the vote
