



Alcohol and Illegal Substance Policy

Phi Sigma Pi National Honor Fraternity discourages but does not prohibit, the use of alcoholic beverages at any Phi Sigma Pi sponsored event, function or meeting, with the exception of New Member and/or Initiate Events. Although, if alcohol is present, Members must follow the proper event planning steps available in the National Risk Management Policy. Illicit use of controlled substances as defined by state and federal law at any Phi Sigma Pi sponsored event, function or meeting is prohibited. All Chapters must adhere to the Phi Sigma Pi Alcohol and Illegal Substance Policy.

Alcohol and Illegal Substance at New Member/Initiate Events

Alcohol and/or illicit use of controlled substances shall be strictly prohibited at any Collegiate Chapter membership drive event. A membership drive event is considered as any Recruitment or Initiation event that is planned for or by the Initiates and/or Potential New Members during the Recruitment and Initiation period. Events including, but not limited to, Pinning of Initiates and the Induction of Members.

Purchase of Alcohol and Illegal Substances

Collegiate Chapters are strictly prohibited from using Official Collegiate Chapter moneys for the purchase and consumption of alcohol and/or controlled substances at any Phi Sigma Pi function. The purchase and/or use of bulk quantity of alcoholic beverages, i.e. kegs or cases, shall be prohibited.

Phi Sigma Pi's Risk Management Policy states the following about alcohol and illegal substances:

- 1** All Official Phi Sigma Pi Events must comply with the National Constitution Article XXI: Prohibitions.
- 2** The possession, sale or use of any illegal drugs or illicit use of controlled substances, is strictly prohibited at all Official Phi Sigma Pi Events.
- 3** Unruly and intoxicated behavior will not be permitted at any Official Phi Sigma Pi Event.
