



Due Process: Expectations of Members

As a Member, you have a right to due process when it is determined that your actions are not in accordance with Chapter or National policy. But before due process even begins, it's important that you know what is expected of you as a Member. Here's what the Membership Agreement says about expectations and what it means to you:

The Membership Agreement:

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Members should always comply with all federal, state, and city laws.

ORGANIZATION POLICY COMPLIANCE

Members should adopt, comply and enforce all written policies and rules as a Member of Phi Sigma Pi to promote a fraternal Brotherhood.

MEMBER RISK MANAGEMENT

Members shall oppose activities deemed as hazing and all forms of harassment (sexual or otherwise), as defined by Phi Sigma Pi's governing documents.

OTHER POLICY COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

Members shall at all times adopt and comply with the sheltering institution or any insurer of Phi Sigma Pi, the Chapter or the sheltering institution.

MEMBER AND CHAPTER AGREEMENT AND FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Chapter agrees to submit the Member's Membership Fees by the deadline set by the National Office.

What this means to you:

Whether you're attending an official Chapter event or just hanging out with other Members, you should never participate in illegal activity.

You are expected to know the policies outlined in the Chapter's governing documents, as well as all National policies so that you can abide by them fully.

In order to ensure the safety of all Members, you should never engage in any behavior that could be considered hazing or harassment. Check out phisigmapi.org/keypolicies to educate yourself on the National Fraternity's policies.

As a Collegiate Member, you are expected to know and follow your college or university's policies. The Student Code of Conduct is a great place to start to learn about all policies, academic and otherwise, which govern student behavior.

You are making a commitment to fulfill all obligations of membership in Phi Sigma Pi, including payment of dues. Your Chapter will determine the deadline for paying local and National dues each term.
