Phi Sigma Pi's History: The Founding

- Founding Date: February 14, 1916
- Established at the State Teachers College in Warrensburg, MO, which is now known as the University of Central Missouri
- Founding Fathers include Dr. Eldo L. Hendricks, Dr. Claude A. Phillips and Dr. C.H. McClure
- Phi Sigma Pi's History: The Founding

Important Dates in Phi Sigma Pi's History

- 1966 "National" and "Honor" are added to the Fraternity's name
- 1977 National Constitution is amended to allow women to join following Title IX
- 1980 Dr. Anita P. Davis (Alpha Alpha Chapter) is elected Historian, making her the first female National Officer
- **1990** The handbook used to teach Initiates about Phi Sigma Pi is renamed The Scholar's Province
- 2001 "Brother," written by Ted Daniels (Alpha Rho Chapter), is adopted as a second official song
- 2014 Grand Chapter adopts a resolution to use the term "gender inclusive" instead of "oo-ed"
- 2015 The Phi Sigma Pi Brothers' Creed is approved by Grand Chapter

- Elected as President in 1928
- Helped to form the Professional Interfraternity Conference with 21 other Professional Fraternities

Initiate Event Planning

Once you have decided on an idea that you would like to pursue, you should create a list of tasks that need to be accomplished.

Some tasks may have smaller tasks that need to be completed. Picking up supplies is a task. Making a shopping list is a subtask.

Once you have your list of tasks and subtasks, set deadlines for when things need to be done.

Initiate Event Planning

When you have your list of tasks and subtasks and when they need to be completed, you can assign group members to be responsible for those items.

You will want to schedule a time to follow up on what has been accomplished and what still needs done.

You may need to set a time to check in before our next meeting.
