Phi Sigma Pi's recruitment program, Surge, was awarded a Pennsylvania Society of Association Excellence (PASAE) Laurel Award for Excellence in Membership Recruitment and Retention. On February 8, 2018, Phi Sigma Pi were presented the award at the Spooky Nook Facility.
