



What are Membership requirements?

We are an active organization on your campus. For approval, you must have a 3.0 GPA, college credits and at least one term remaining.

The next step to membership includes completing the Member Education Program and join us for an Induction Ceremony (currently performed online due to COVID).

Participation in our nationally renowned leadership program, access to National Events, availability of a letter of recommendation, applying for volunteer opportunities, etc. will become available to you once you are inducted into the organization.

Are there Membership Fees?

Yes, as a nonprofit organization that provides opportunities to advance humanity, there is a membership fee for our evergrowing resources. If you are eligible, and joining the Chapter at your campus, your first term of dues is \$183. This includes your membership certificate, membership pin and decal.

Once in the Chapter, National dues include \$78 for semester schools and \$52 for quarter schools.

Steps to Joining

- 1. Fill out the interest application to let us know you want to join.
- 2.Claim your membership profile sent to your email.
- 3. Learn about Phi Sigma Pi and complete the Member Education Program.
- 4.Get connected with the Chapter on your campus.
